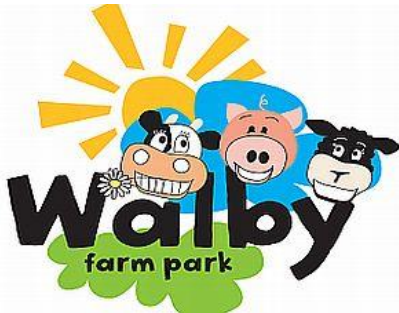
The Juniors have been rehearsing their “Snappy Opera” songs again this week.
