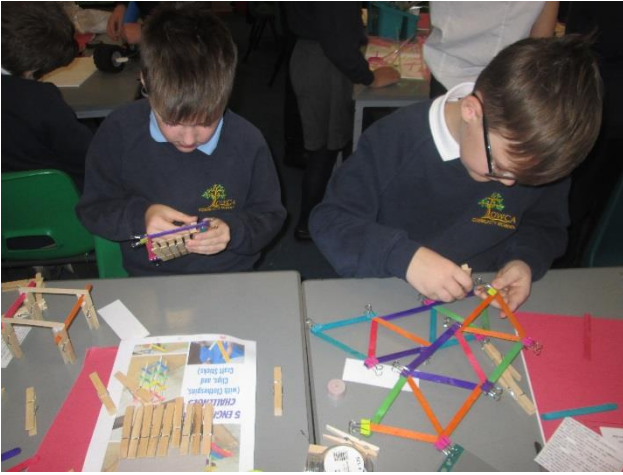
Electricity Cut

The children have really enjoyed “Engineering week”. They have had lots of innovative ideas and designed and developed many products.



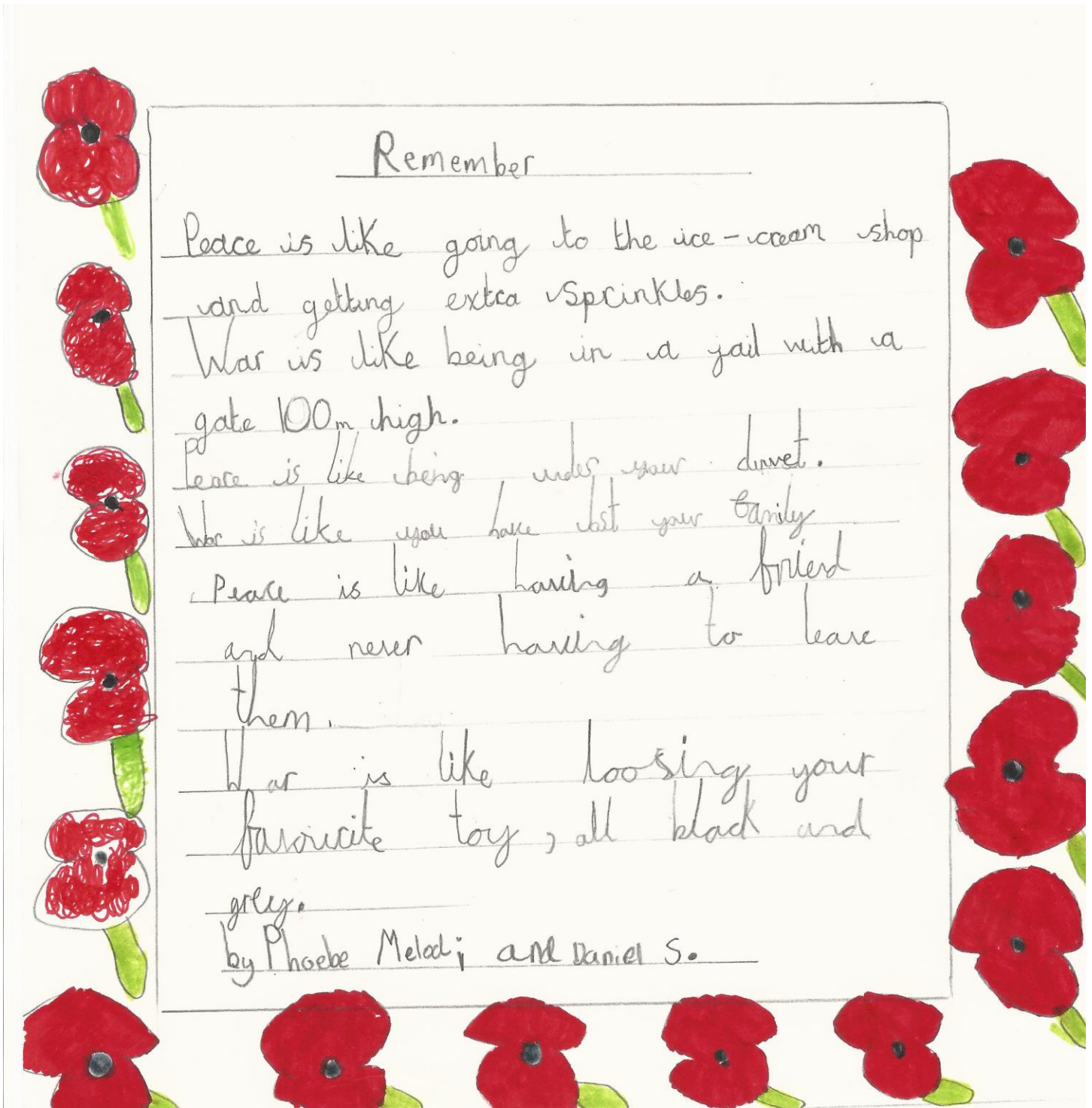
On Tuesday we were joined by Mr Brooks from Nuvia to talk to us about Maths and Engineering in real life.
