## Traffic safety- All parents please note.

### Child being run over

Please could all parents stop turning in the area between the school and Micklam terrace! As the children walk down the pavement they are at risk from being run over when people turn. They are unaware that their pavement turns into "road" here. Instead, please go less than a minute further up, and use the turning circle. Alternatively, please park near the bottom gate and walk up the path we specially created to reduce traffic hazards. Even better, try walking up to school and join in with the national walk to school week.

In my early career, one of my pupils was killed on the road, so it is a tragedy I am committed to preventing here. Our community police officer, Hollie, will also be visiting. She will be reminding everyone to drive slowly and not to use this side area for turning, during dropping off and picking up of pupils. She has also asked me to make a note of any car registration numbers that put the children at risk by turning here. These will be reported to her, so that she can contact these people personally. If you see any one doing this, I would ask that you make a note of the registration and let me know.
