

Bassenfell Reminders 2021

Dear Parents and Carers,

Please find below a few reminders in regards to our much anticipated residential at Bassenfell tomorrow:

Arrive at school at 8:50, as normal. We will be leaving at about 9:30.

Please pack the things from the kit lists with your child, so they know which items are theirs. They also need a sleeping bag and pillow case. Please use a **small** suitcase or bag that they can carry themselves and pop it in Mr Crawford's black Freelander car or Mrs. Draper's white BMW car which will be parked at the front of school. Children can then go in to their own classroom carrying their packed lunches (in a disposable bag). Any labelled medication should be given to Mrs. Crawford with written dosage instructions by the dropping off adult not the child please.

We will be making our own fun, so no electronic games, i-pods, chocolate, (although a SMALL bag of sweets is OK to sneak in their luggage for a midnight feast.) No chewing gum, cameras or phones- thank you. No pocket money is needed either. Please bring roll on deodorants rather than aerosol types in case it triggers an asthma attack.

Reception pupils will be brought back to school around 5.00pm on Wednesday evening and dropped off at the post box opposite the war memorial.

Key st.1 and 2 will arrive back at school on Thursday ready for normal pick up time at **3.15pm**. There is no need to arrive earlier than the normal pick up time. If fine the luggage will be outside at the front entrance. If wet please collect luggage from the hall through the conservatory door.

Finally I'd just like to say a big thank you for letting us borrow your child/ children for this adventure holiday. I promise they will have a great time and that we will really look after them.
