Class 1: Damian for his superb attitude to his learning.

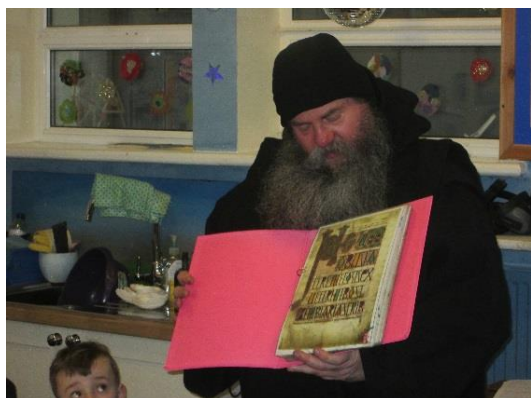
Class 2: Cooper for remembering to join his writing and being fantastic at maths.

Class 1: Class one this week have been enjoying their rainforest topic, we have been learning which animals live in the different 'layers' of the forest. Reception children in outdoor science discovered how to make 'tissue paper' frogs jump using friction to cause static electricity. If you have a balloon at home try extending this knowledge by rubbing it and 'sticking' it to wall or making your hair stand on end! Year 1 have been recapping o'clock and they are all sound with this- ask your child through the day 'What time is it?' Next week we will revisit 'half past' the hour. Please could all Reception, yr.1 and yr. 2 bring a shoe box in to school on Wednesday to make a "rainforest 3-D world" in Art and Design.

Class 2: We have been revisiting telling the time in half hours, quarter hours and 5 minute intervals. Keep practising your times tables on "topmarks" guys. In English we have written stories about the Ethiopian tale "stone soup" and poems about volcanoes linking with our topic on Earth, Rocks and Soil. We have been making our sentences "fancy" with lots of adjectives and adverbs.

Class 3: We have had another busy week in the juniors. On Monday in science we learned about fossils and how soil was and is made. Then we used our historical and maths skills and learned how to be archaeologists. We measured and plotted our 'finds' onto scaled plans. Everyone worked really hard all afternoon.



On Wednesday we had a visit from Brother Mellitus who taught us all about Anglo-Saxon Benedictine monks and their work on the illuminated texts. We used our science skills and knowledge to create our own ink and paints just as the Saxons and Isaac Newton and Michelangelo would have done. We wrote and drew with quill and reed pens and began our own illuminated page work. Brother Mellitus answered all of our questions and shared his vast knowledge with us during the day. It was fascinating and we were so surprised when the clock told us it was 3.15!
