Class 1: Reception have been recapping their phonic sounds including ng, ch, oa, ai, ar, th and sh. They are enjoying hearing the story of The Magic Faraway Tree by Enid Blyton being read to them. In Maths, we have practiced reading the numbers 1-10 and matching them to the same amount shown as a picture. On Wednesday morning we had a lovely walk around Lowca with year 1, exploring some of our nearby man-made features in Lowca.

In the infants this week we have been busy looking at maps and understanding where things are in our local environment. We were fascinated to have a peek into the telephone cabinet next to the bus stop. The man working on it told us that to be a telephone engineer you have to be good at climbing and know how to use computers. Year 1 have been working on subtraction and using knowledge of number bonds to achieve this.

Class 2: We love to learn from direct experiences so making Viking soup was the perfect opportunity to explore halves, thirds and quarters. The children experimented with cutting whole vegetables into equal parts. Then we counted backwards and forwards in halves using carrots. Then we worked out some calculations using halves.

Class 3: This week the juniors have been learning about Viking Longships and looking at why and where the Vikings travelled. This morning we had an amazing African drumming sessions with Zozo our visiting musician. We are all looking forward to our trip back to Viking times on Tuesday 21st when we visit Moorforge –please make sure you child has plenty of warm clothes plus spare as we will be without central heating all day.
