## Medical First Aid up-date

Further to our recent first aid training we have been advised that when taking a preventer (brown) inhaler or a reliever (blue) inhaler to relieve an attack, A SPACER SHOULD ALWAYS BE USED. The spacer flask allows more of the medication fine powder to be delivered in the lungs. In addition to always letting you know when your child has had a head injury, we will also be letting you know if your child has had a trip or fall in case the bone is in danger of being broken but the break was not initially apparent. We will let you know by text and ask you to reply to confirm you have got the message.
