Class 1: Thank you to Reception parents for sending in bits for junk modelling. We had lots of fun using string, tape and glue to join them together and then decorate them. Thank you too for putting captions and pictures in the yellow books for the children to talk about in show and tell each week. They love talking about things they have done out of school.

Class one have been busy this week with lots of learning. In maths we have been subtracting, adding and measuring length, height and width. Ask your child if they can show how long a centimetre is, about how long 10cm and 30cm. In English we have begun reading comprehension so they have to use their skills of reading to answer questions. So when your reading remember to ask your child what they have read about. Thank you for your continued support with spelling, but allow your child to write their word too when using spelling shed.

Class 2: In maths this week we have been recording information in charts and answering questions about charts. We have also been measuring tiny things using mm's. In English we have written a story about a friendship machine with a structured beginning, middle and end. We have also been looking at vocabulary reading comprehension questions, as well as how to use the rest of the paragraph to work out the meaning of words.

Class 3: This week has been another busy week in the juniors. On Monday and Tuesday the children learned about Rube Goldberg and, in teams, designed and built their own machines. We were really impressed with the children's engineering skills, imagination and team work skills. On Wednesday and Thursday class 3 learned how to use Publisher to create a leaflet and persuade people to buy their machines, in maths, class 3 have been busy measuring. Year 4 have been measuring and walking a kilometre, Year 5 have been measuring volume and capacity and year 6 have been converting between miles and kilometres. In art the children have been finishing Romero Britto art and starting a project on art using robotics. In music everyone has been working hard on the keyboards.

This week is the last week for block one of swimming. Please can you make sure that your child has their indoor and outdoor P.E kits in school every day next week as we be looking at putting a second P.E session into the timetable.
