Try this with your child- ask them how many they have and then ask them how many they would have if they had 'one more'. Y1 and Y2 have been revisiting number bonds-ask them who will be friends with 7 to make 10, or who will be friends with 17 to make 20. We have been constructing simple sentences including capitals and full stops. Well done with the spellings- loads of evidence of practice at home which is having a great impact on the children.

**Juniors** 'This week we have had a lady called Phil come in to teach us about rivers and streams. She also taught us about lots of things not to put in rivers and what lives in them. There was also a stuffed fish, otter and bird. The otter was really cute. This week we also researched about the 'Insight' that is launching onto Mars on Monday.
