**Class 1** Reception children have been learning about seasonal changes and have been out in the garden observing the changes and growth of the plants, and they have observed lots of changes happening. They have been having lots of fun doing ‘group reading’ and following along with stories in this way. They have been re-enforcing their number work by grouping, ordering and writing them down. In science we have been looking at food and nutrition and seeing how these affect our bodies. Year 1’s have been amazing with their ‘data handling’, they have come up with their own ideas of ‘criteria’ to sort as well as using criteria that was provided for them. We also learned more pirate words and phrases.

**Class 2** Year 2’s have really mastered the concept of times tables and are now converting analogue times to digital times. In shape they have been drawing tessellating triangles and tessellating hexagons as well as finding right angles in shapes. They have also been keeping their column addition skills sharp using tens and unit cubes. In English they have been sorting pirate facts into different headings for their non-fiction writing.



The puppet show was titled ‘Who Cares?’ and was based around the Good Samaritan Parable. Some of our younger pupils were asked to take part and really enjoyed playing some of the puppet parts. All the school children really enjoyed the production that was kindly put on for us free of charge.

**Class 3** Class 3 really enjoyed their class visit from research scientist Nikki Ngombe on Monday. They asked her lots of questions to do with her work and her qualifications and also about her involvement with our 'Unlocke Project'. All of the children have written and edited their 500 words stories, and are going to share them with each other and the lower school pupils on Monday before they are submitted for entry to the BBC competition.
