Reception children have been working hard on number recognition, sequencing numbers then writing the numbers correctly. In phonics, the children have begun word building using the knowledge they have already gained. Year 1 and 2 have been doing lots of work finding out about odd and even numbers. We have looked at patterns and found out how with very large numbers you just need to look at the last number to work out if it's odd or even. Give your child a large number and ask them to tell you which one it is!
