Please wear warm old clothes on Thursdays for infant's outdoor science.

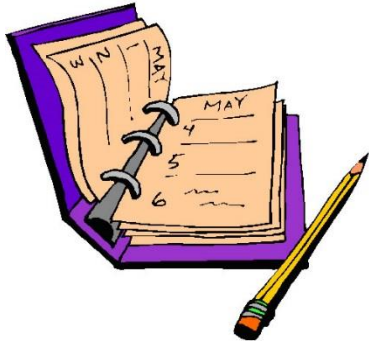
Please note...Dinner money has gone up to £10.50 per week or £2.10 per day.
