Class 1:

Good to see everyone after a much needed rest. This week we have been assessing the children's knowledge of phase 2 phonics and the majority of them are now ready to move on to phase 3. Our new topic of space is proving popular with the children especially making rockets and linking them to fireworks! We found out about Guy Fawkes and have a simple understanding of why we have Bonfire night. They enjoyed ordering their fireworks in maths too and are recognising numerals.

Class 2:

This week our new topic of space has begun. So far we have learned about months of the year and the zodiac as well as the phases of the moon. Continuing with our measuring time topic we have also been counting in 5s ready for reading the clock in 5 minute intervals. In maths we have also made 3D rockets from cones and cylinders. In English we have written about Guy Fawkes and enjoyed playing phonics bingo.

Class 3:

This week the children have had a super start to our new topic, Robots, Computers and Electricity. In English we have started our new reading focus, The Iron Man, using comprehension skills and building scripts to creatively look at different points of view. We have started to explore different types of length and convert units. We have shared ideas and current knowledge on electricity and the history of robots. As a class we have discussed how to stay safe online and how to use technology safely and effectively. This week we are starting to hand out weekly reading books. There will be a note included to explain what to do to help build and support the children's reading skills. Class 4:

This week the children have been very excited to start their new topic Robots, Computers and Electricity they have been very busy building wobble bots in science. The children are also looking forward to a STEM day on Monday where they will be looking at electricity and building moving models and alarms.
