CLASS 1 This week Class 1 have been super busy! We have continued to practise our phonics skills by practising letter formations not only on paper, but using outdoor activities too, using water and paint to explore letter journeys. In Maths we have played games to practise our matching skills, as well as explore comparing different objects and have talked about how we can group them. On Wednesday we had a super Teddy Bears picnic day, making our own sandwiches and baking and decorating our lovely biscuits. At Hawes End the children were brilliant! They all had a super time exploring the Pirate Island and following the clues to find the treasure! They also used problem solving skills during a puzzle afternoon.
